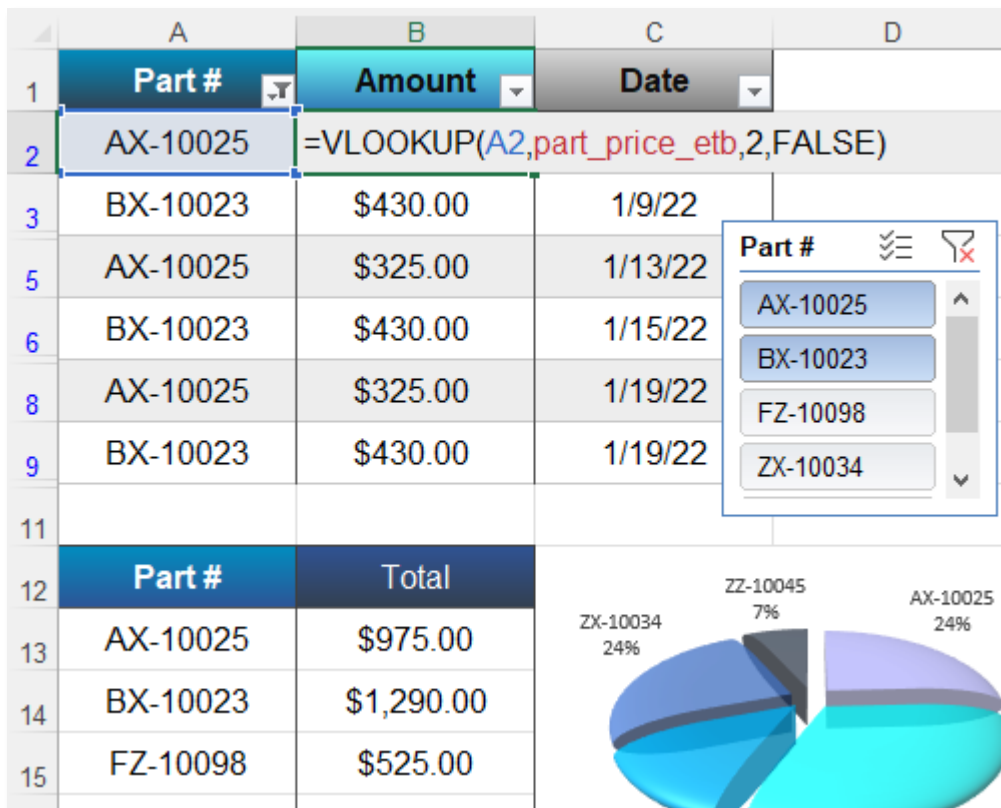

Laying Out Problems, Entering Data, and Building Formulas on the Worksheet

- Organizing your problem on the worksheet for easy user entry and formula construction
- Formatting your worksheet problem including cell coloring, borders, fonts, and alignments
- Review of worksheet data entry, number formats, and how Excel really stores data
- Using operators, cells, ranges, and basic functions (i.e., SUM, MAX, SUBTOTAL...) to build formulas
- How to build and use cell names to easily track cell information in formulas and other Excel features
- Using sheet references and cell names in your formulas to track information on multiple worksheets

Building Worksheet and Excel Tables to Store Data

Using Data Validation and Conditional Formatting to Control and Flag Data

- What is Conditional Formatting and how is it used to flag worksheet data based on logic?

- How to edit and delete a Conditional Formatting logic rule

Filtering, Sorting, and Grouping Worksheet Data to Make Reports

- Hiding and unhiding worksheet rows and columns using the Group feature
- Using the Sort feature to sort worksheet data based on text, colors, icons...
- Using the Autofilter and Advanced Filter tools to build powerful report filters for worksheet data
- Copying and pasting parts of filtered and sorted worksheet data to report worksheets, PasteSpecial reviewed
- Using Excel table filters, slicers, and quick summary tools to rapidly report worksheet data

Performing Table Lookups and Merging Worksheet Data

- Rules for designing a worksheet table that can be used by the lookup functions
- Using VLOOKUP, HLOOKUP, and XLOOKUP to lookup table information
- Using XMATCH and MATCH to find item position (i.e., 1, 2, 3...) within a row or column

- How to use INDEX to perform table lookups that XLOOKUP and VLOOKUP cannot

Using Logic to Make Decisions in Your Formulas

- What is logic and how to leverage it in your formulas to make decisions?
- The basics of determining logic triggers in your worksheet data
- Review of building logic formulas using the relational operators: <, >, <=, >=, < >, =
- Review of building logic formulas using the IF, AND, OR, NOT, and IS logical functions
- Using IF to decide what formula to run or what value to output based on logic criteria
- Using IF and IS to create formulas that disappear or return a value when an input is missing, or an error occurs

Using Logic to Summarize and Count Worksheet Data

- How to build the logic criteria for the SUMIF, SUMIFS, COUNTIFS, MAXIFS... functions
- Using SUMIF, SUMIFS to summarize your worksheet data based on logic
- Using COUNTIF, COUNTIFS to count how many instances of an item are in your data based on logic
- Using COUNTIF to determine if worksheet tables have matching content
- How to use MAXIFS, MINIFS, AVERAGEIFS... to determine max, min, and average values based on logic

Analyzing Dates and Times in Your Worksheet Data

- Extracting the month and day name from your date values using the TEXT function
- Using the DAY, MONTH, YEAR, DATE, TIME... functions to break down and create date time values
- Using the TODAY, NOW, and EOMONTH functions to generate various date times including end of month date
- How to use the NETWORKDAYS.INTL and WORKDAY.INTL functions to calculate the # of workdays between dates or from a date
- Assembling valid date time values from multiple columns of data

Importing, Parsing, and Cleaning Text Data on the Worksheet

- Using Text Wizard to import downloaded text files onto a worksheet
- Using Text to Columns to separate delimited worksheet data into separate worksheet columns
- How to use Remove Duplicates to retrieve unique values from repeating worksheet data
- Parsing, trimming, and cleaning worksheet text using functions like LEFT, MID, SUBSTITUTE, TRIM, CLEAN...
- How to use string concatenation to merge worksheet text data

Creating and Formatting Industry Grade Charts

- Creating the worksheet tables that are used for various Excel chart types
- How to create and format various chart types including combo charts, pie, column, line...
- Creating vertical limit lines, horizontal limit lines, gridlines, titles, data labels... in charts
- How to create a secondary chart axis
- How to make a chart template for rapid reporting
- Laying out charts on worksheets to make a chart report
